CASS & Friends Safeguarding Policy Do's and Don'ts

Do	Don't
Conduct all 1:1 meetings over zoom	Meet athletes alone
Copy parents in on all email correspondence	Email athletes directly without copying their parents
Ensure another parent or coach is present at all face to face meetings with athletes	Ignore any concerns regarding the athletes welfare
Keep up to date DBS checks on all trustees and volunteers conducting the 8 week mindset programme	
Ask parents if they are happy for trustees or volunteers to make contact with athletes on social media	
Contact the relevant welfare office at the club the athlete belongs to if there is any concern at all that an athlete is in any danger	
Use the relevant NGB or club policies as guidelines where necessary	
Keep a log of communication during any incident	
Follow the CASS & Friends code of practise key principles – “open and honest mentoring, listening to athletes and parents if they have concerns and get involved with third parties if we are aware of abuse taking place.”
